Course sponsored by Freeport-McMoRan Inc.

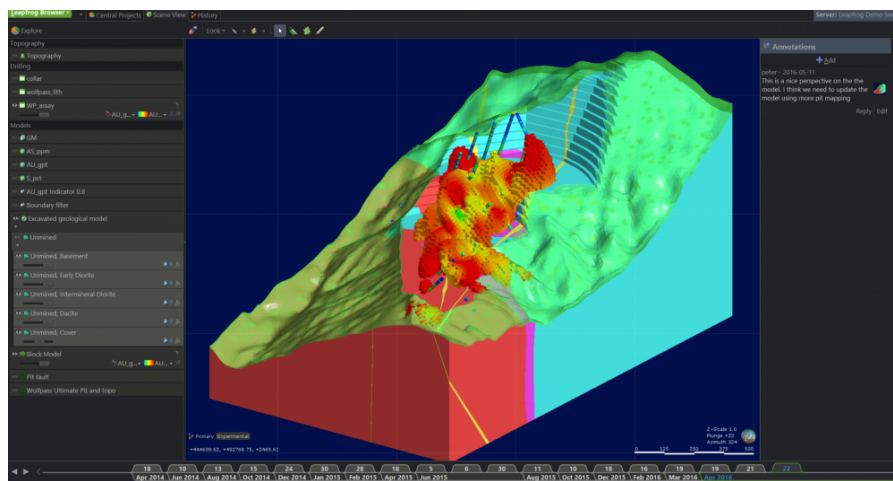

This 2-day short course is designed for junior- to mid-level mining engineers and metallurgists and introduces the role of geologists and geology at each stage of the mine planning process, from exploration to environmental remediation. Topics include ore deposit geology and mineralogy; geometallurgy; geological models and block models; geological inputs to geotechnics; ore control; and environmental geology.

The course is taught by a group of academic and industry geologists and mining engineers. No prior knowledge of geology is required. Lunch will be provided both days.
